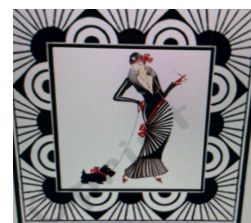

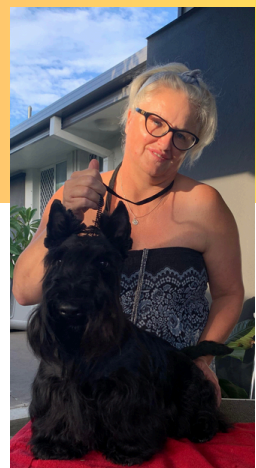

# *The Sun Puppy Book*

by Charles Barrett

It is amazing what you can find when you start looking through piles of old magazines in vintage shops. I came across this magazine called *The Sun Puppy Book* by Charles Barrett, so I quickly snapped it up before I had a proper look through its pages. I had a feeling it was a bit more than vintage from the one shilling price on the cover but there was no publication date so I had to do a little bit of digging so I started with the author.

Charles Barrett was an Australian naturalist, and journalist and from 1906 to 1939 wrote for the *Melbourne Herald*. Between 1932 and 1937 Charles authored *The Sun Nature* books of which *The Puppy* book is Number 7 of 10 and was published in 1936. What is also amazing is that all the photographs of the breeds are from Australian breeders of the 1930s and taken by H.C.F. Morant, the official photographer of the Kennel Control Council (Victoria).

Intrigued by the puppy on the front cover I carefully began turning the pages and reading the stories of the dog breeds found inside the pages. They include the Scottish Terrier described as 'Scotland's Pride' and many other terrier breeds including Australian Terriers, Sealyhams, West Highland White, and the Cairn. There is also a fascinating number advertisements for breeders including "Winton Kennels" of Pugs and Scottish Terriers "Boasting" the newest imported strains of Scottish Terriers and that was in 1936!

However, out of all the breeds and puppies described in this book by the author Charles Barrett in the last paragraph of the introduction, he noted his preference was for the Scottie.

I will have the book made into digital form for the Club and in the meantime here are a few photo snapshots.

## SCOTTISH TERRIERS

Scotland's Pride, the Scottish Terrier, often a rather dour-looking dog, can be charming. He may glower at a stranger, or smile. He is intelligent; he is faithful, and second to none of the Terrier clan in hardhood and pluck. His owner adores him; and the Scottie, commonly known as "Die-hard," has qualities that win affection and justify ownership pride.

As a puppy the Scottish Terrier perhaps is most engaging. His play is of the baby elephant kind, and romping around, the wiry-coated youngster upsets any light objects in his track. His bright eyes are smiling, or expressive of wonder. He becomes solemn in a moment, sitting with clumsy paws outspread, then is chasing the slipper or chewing the covers off a book on the floor.

Plenty of mischief in the Scottie's make-up, even when puppyhood has been left behind.

Before the Scottish Terrier Club was formed in England, the Scottie was known as the Aberdeen Terrier, a name still often used. He came originally from the North of Scotland, principally the neighborhood of Aberdeen, and was bred solely as a worker, without reference to standard at all.

No wonder that the fanciers who took up the sturdy Highlander found a diversity of types. Faults of shape and size were bred

out of him; he became shorter, with a straight front, and the crookedness of his forelegs was modified.

Your modern Scottish Terrier is a muscular and powerful short-legged dog, whose long head has "punishing" jaws and sharp-pointed, small, erect ears. He is densely coated all over the body with hard and wiry hair, weighs from 17lbs. to 18lbs., and stands between 9 inches and 12 inches high at the shoulder. A picture of power, for the size of the dog. His tail, about 7 inches in length, is carried nearly erect, a slight bend at most, and often jauntily.

Look for these points in a Scottish Terrier puppy: long and level head, of course, with strong jaws, small ears carried erect and close together, a body short and round, straight forelegs. A dense wiry coat the pup should have, and small dark colored eyes, bright and piercing.
